OUT OF ZONE ENROLMENTS

Our out of zone enrolments will be opening on Monday 2nd September. If you are interested in applying for an out of zone position please download the out of zone intention to enrol form from our website: www.bayview.school.nz

The Bayview Board of Trustees has decided to allow for only 35 out of zone places. Please note if we receive more than 35 applications we will have to go to a ballot according to the following priorities (set by the Ministry of Education)

Applicants are accepted in this order:

- First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme (please note this does not apply at Bayview School).
- Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school
- Third priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- Forth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of trustees or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

If the Board of trustees receives fewer applications than there are places available, all applicants will be enrolled.

If you currently live within our school zone and have a child starting school at any time during the 2020 academic year, please fill in the intention to enrol form to help us with future planning.

Our enrolment zone can be found on our website or there is a copy in the office.

NEW PLAYGROUND

The Ministry of Education have all the paperwork so we are now waiting on permission to proceed. Fingers crossed this will be completed quickly so that we can have the playground installed and ready for the 2020 school year.




Bayview Community Centre Photography Workshop
