### **AFTER SCHOOL ISSUES**

Mr Corbett is our caretaker and he works really hard to ensure our grounds are a safe environment. Erik has mentioned that he is finding a huge amount of rubbish around the school from children and adults using our grounds out of school time. Mrs Terry has collected a weeks worth of rubbish and the majority has been coffee cups, McDonalds wrappers and takeaway containers. We are working hard to educate the children around taking their own rubbish home after their morning tea and lunches but we need your help to ensure weekend rubbish is also taken home. We do not have rubbish bins around our school as we want people to try their hardest to reduce the amount of packaging they buy. Please be a tidy kiwi and ensure you take responsibility for your own rubbish!

We have also noticed a large number of children hanging around in the school grounds after 3pm, unsupervised. Please note that once the bell has gone your children should leave the school grounds and go straight home. If they have to wait for you they should do that in the Fale's. We have children who are playing around the school, wandering through classrooms, playing in the hall with our production props, all unsupervised by an adult. This is a care and protection issue especially for the under 5's! Please note that after school staff are engaged in a range of meetings and are unable to monitor your children. After 3pm they are parents' responsibility.


### **MAKING GREAT CHOICES**

At Bayview we actively encourage children to make great choices. We talk with the children often about the fact that they are responsible for their choices. If they are successful it will be as a result of their hard work and attitude. They are in control of their attitude and their choices.

Lately we have noticed that we have students who like to 'get involved' with issues or challenges that do not involve them. Essentially they are being nosey and stirring up trouble. Sadly there are always people who see a drama and like to get involved, but this often ends up in more drama and worse consequences. These people don't get to know the entire story and can take things out of context and create something bigger than it actually is that is filled with inaccuracies.

We have given our senior students a very strong message that "If it isn't your business, then stay out of it!". We give these messages to all our students and hope you will reinforce this at home.

Our aim is to create socially responsible humans who know when to be an upstander but also when to stay out of other people's business.


