Welcome back to school! What a wonderful start to the new school year. Lots of happy children and happier parents!

This year we have lots of fun and exciting learning and events planned and alongside this we will be unwrapping our new school vision that everyone had input into. With everything, there will be some changes made to better serve our learners and you as parents and caregivers.

One of the things we are changing is how we connect with you about your child at the beginning of the year. In the past we have held expectation meetings where you can meet with your child's teacher and find out how they run their classrooms and the expectations they have around what your child needs to do. This year this information will be sent home in written format. This is so that you will be able to keep this in a central place to refer back to. What we do want to do this year is get to know your child better and learn more about the things that are important to your child i.e. their family.
